Is wear to you by the One Who Created the Heavens and the Earth on the Day of Judgment you will wish that for 5 minutes you would have been at that line in the airport in the Next Life you will wish that for one moment you would have been in the place of one of those Muslims that were oppressed for one moment you will wish you were one of the worst oppressed Muslim in the planet rather than the situation that will be facing you when you stand before your Creator.

So, you can laugh at us now, you can make fun of us now all what you want.

The Day the real laughter will come is the Day that we enter into Jannah (Paradise) and we leave you behind. Then Islam will give me that type of Ezzah (pride).

Laugh now, go ahead, laugh !

Even if I tell you what Islam is about you will laugh at me and mock me. Go ahead, I actually sit down and let you finish, Because I am gonna have my Day.
